## P R E F A C E

This publication comprises the world aggregate whaling results for 1977, i. e. the catch by Antarctic pelagic expeditions in the Southern Hemisphere in the 1976/77 season and the catch of other expeditions and shore stations during the calendar year 1977. With regard to the Japanese coastal catch of sperm whales, see Introduction.

Statistical data have not been received from Portugal (Azores and Madeira), Spain, Chile and Somali Republic.

## INTRODUCTION

Details of Antarctic pelagic whaling in the season 1976/77 will be found in publication No. LXXX.

In the North Pacific one Japanese, two USSR pelagic expeditions and 4 Japanese shore stations operated in 1977. The quota set was:

The total quota of Bryde's whales and sperm whales was divided into national quotas between Japan and USSR. The national quotas and catches were:

In addition Japan caught 248 minke whales.

According to Schedule paragraph 3(c) the open season for the taking of sperm whales shall not exceed eight continuous months in any period of twelve months. For the coastal sperm whaling Japan declared an open season from August 1, 1977 to March 31, 1978. At the recommendation of the Scientific Committee of the International Whaling Commission the catch in the North Pacific relating to each continuous season has been referred to the calendar year when whaling operations started. Thus the coastal catch of sperm whales from August 1, 1977 to March 31, 1978 has been recorded as the 1977 season's catch.

For the pelagic season in the Southern Hemisphere the catch has been referred to the calendar year when whaling operations ceased. (See publication No. LXXI, page 7.)

There was no catch of fin whales in Newfoundland and North Norway waters. In Iceland one shore station with 4 catchers were in operation, and the catch amounted to:

The quotas set for the Southern Hemisphere for the 1976/77 pelagic season and the 1977 coastal season were:

1,863 sei whales  
8,900 minke whales  
3,894 sperm whale males  
897 sperm whale females.

These quotas were split into national quotas by agreement between Japan, USSR, Brazil and Australia.

In the Introduction to International Whaling Statistics No. LXXX the quotas and catches for the Japanese and USSR Antarctic pelagic expeditions are given for the season 1976/77 by Area for sei and minke whales and by Division for sperm whales.

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<sup>\*</sup>) Total catch shall not exceed 1,524 fin whales in the six years 1977 to 1982 inclusive, and the total catch in any one year shall not exceed 304.

In addition to the quotas mentioned above, Japan issued a special permit for no more than 240 Southern Hemisphere Bryde's whales to be caught for scientific research purposes. A total of 225 were taken, all north of 40° S.

The quotas set by the Commission apply to member nations of the Commission. Chile, Peru, Portugal, Spain and Korea are not members of the Commission.

Since International Whaling Statistics No. LXXIX was published, information has been received from Peru of catch and production in 1976. (See tables t and Z<sup>1</sup>). Length frequencies in meters of sei, Bryde's and sperm whales taken in 1976 and 1977 will be found in table 6<sup>9</sup>.

According to unofficial reports from Chile 87 and 61 whales were caught in 1976 and 1977 respectively.

At the last meeting of the International Whaling Commission the USSR delegation presented a table showing whales caught by USSR aborigines. The catches for the period 1948—1968 inclusive have not previously been recorded in the International Whaling Statistics. In the said period only gray whales were caught, and the result was as follows:

The catch by USSR aborigines for 1969—1977 inclusive will be found in table o. Some corrections have been made with regard to previously published International Whaling Statistics.

Tables Z<sup>2</sup>—Z<sup>11</sup> show the catches of small whales including the catches made by Antarctic pelagic expeditions.

From the United States Department of Commerce information has previously been received of the estimated incidental kill of Delphinids by US tuna fishermen (see Introduction to publications No. LXXIII, LXXV, LXXVII and LXXIX).

The United States Department of Commerce now reports that the figures previously given refer to the estimated number of dolphins and porpoises killed by fishermen of all nationalities participating in the international tuna purse seine fishery.

Since International Whaling Statistics No. LXXIX was published, information has been received of the catch of pilot whales from the West Indies in 1975 and 1976, which was 135 and 117 respectively (tables Z<sup>2</sup> and Z<sup>5</sup>).

Since the tables to this publication were printed information has been received of catch of whales from Korea in 1976 and 1977. The catch amounted to:
