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P R E F A C E

This publication comprises the world aggregate whaling results for 1978, i.e. the catch by Antarctic pelagic expeditions in the Southern Hemisphere in the 1977/78 season and the catch of other expeditions and shore stations during the calendar year 1978. With regard to the Japanese coastal catch of sperm whales, see Introduction.

Statistical data have not been received from Cypros.

INTRODUCTION

Details of Antarctic pelagic whaling in the season 1977/78 will be found in publication No. LXXXII.

In the North Pacific one Japanese, three USSR pelagic expeditions and four Japanese shore stations operated in 1978. One of the USSR expeditions operated from May 14 to June 2 between 19° and 28° North when returning from the Antarctic after the 1977/78 season.

In addition Japan caught 400 minke whales.

According to Schedule paragraph 3(c) the open season for the taking of sperm whales shall not exceed eight continuous months in any period of twelve months. For the coastal sperm whaling Japan declared an open season from August 1, 1978 to March 31, 1979. At the recommendation of the Scientific Committee of the International Whaling Commission the catch in the North Pacific relating to each continuous season has been referred to the calendar year when whaling operations started. Thus the

coastal catch of sperm whales from August 1, 1978 to March 31, 1979 has been recorded as the 1978 season's catch.

For the Southern Hemisphere pelagic season, the catch has been referred to the calendar year when whaling operation ceased. (See publication No. LXXI, page 7.)

The quotas for sei and minke whales were subdivided on an Area basis and the quota for sperm whales on a Division basis. Further the quotas were split into national quotas by agreement between Japan, USSR, Brazil and Australia.

In the Introduction to International Whaling Statistics No. LXXXII the national quotas (page 8) and the catches for the Japanese and USSR pelagic expeditions are given for the season 1977/78 by Area and for sperm whales also by Division.

In addition to the quotas mentioned above, Japan and USSR issued special permits for no more than 120 and 5 Bryde's whales respectively to be caught for scientific research purposes. A total of 119 were taken, all north of 40° South.

At the 31st meeting of the International Whaling Commission in 1979 a paper was presented (SC/31/Doc. 58) showing «Korean whale catches by species. 1962—1978». In table y will be found the catch of large whales and in table Z³ the catch of minke whales from 1965 to 1978. From 1962 to 1964 inclusive 252, 364 and 472 whales were caught, but no information of species is available.

According to earlier information on Korean catches, large whales included mainly fin whales (see publication No. LXXXI, table y, page 24). The data presented above show that Bryde's whales and not fin whales have been reported caught. The International Whaling Commission hopes to confirm the species identification shortly.

From the International Whaling Commission a table has been received showing Spanish statistics for 1971—1978 inclusive. The figures for 1971—1974 are in disagreement with previous information regarding the number of catchers used. The new Spanish statistics will be found in table 1.

Catches of humpback whales not previously reported to International Whaling Statistics have taken place from Tonga Islands. The catches from 1973 to 1978 inclusive will be found in table v².

Revised statistics from Peru and Chile have been received through the International Whaling Commission (see tables t and u.).

According to the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, Great Britain, the following number of humpback whales has been taken since 1974 at the Island of Bequia in the St. Vincent Group:

Tables Z²—Z¹¹ show the catches of small whales reported to International Whaling Statistics. No reports have been received of incidental kill of delphinids by tuna fishermen (see Introduction to publication No. LXXXI, page 10).

The figures for the Greenlanders catch of whales and porpoises given in tables Z²—Z¹¹ are provisional. The figures presented in previous volumes are not in full agreement with summaries of the «List of Game» published by the Ministry of Greenland. A revision of the statistics for the last decade is in progress by said Ministry and will be published later.
