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P R E F A C E

This publication comprises the world aggregate whaling results for 1979, i.e. the catch by Antarctic pelagic expeditions in the Southern Hemisphere in the 1978/79 season and the catch of other expeditions and shore stations during the calendar year 1979. With regard to the Japanese coastal catch of sperm whales, see Introduction.

Statistical data have not been received from Cyprus, The West Indies and Tonga Islands.

INTRODUCTION

Details of quotas and whales caught in the Southern Hemisphere by Antarctic pelagic expeditions are published in International Whaling Statistics No. LXXXIV.

In 1979 one Japanese and three USSR pelagic expeditions, and four Japanese shore stations operated in the North Pacific. One of the USSR expeditions ("Sovjetskaya Rossia") operated from November 29 to December 6, 1979 between 0° and 3° North and 101° and 112° West on its way to the Antarctic, and 201 sperm whales were caught.

The quotas set for the North Pacific were 454 Bryde's whales (Western Stock), 400 minke whales (Okhotsk Sea — West Pacific Stock), 2,698 male sperm whales in the Western Division, 1,102 male sperm whales in the Eastern Division, total 3,800 of which 11.5 % could be a by-catch of female sperm whales.

The quotas for Bryde's whales and sperm whales in the North Pacific were divided into national quotas between Japan and USSR. The national quotas and catches were:

In addition Japan caught 407 minke whales.

According to Schedule paragraph 3(c) the open season for the taking of sperm whales shall not exceed eight continuous months in any period of twelve months. For the coastal sperm whaling Japan declared an open season from August 1, 1979 to March 31, 1980. At the recommendation of the Scientific Committee of the International Whaling Commission the catch in the North Pacific relating to each continuous season has been referred to the calendar year when whaling operations started. Thus the coastal catch of sperm whales from August 1, 1979 to March 31, 1980 has been recorded as the 1979 season's catch.

For the Southern Hemisphere pelagic season, the catch has been referred to the calendar year when whaling operation ceased. (See publication No. LXXI, page 7.)

No whaling for fin whales took place off Newfoundland or off North Norway. Seven fin and 14 humpback whales were caught off West Greenland and 11 fin whales and 1 sei whale off the Faroe Islands. In Iceland one shore station with four catchers operated, and the catch amounted to:

260 fin whales
84 sei whales
96 sperm whales

During the three seasons 1977—1979, 640 fin whales have been caught off Iceland.

In addition to these quotas, Japan issued special permits for taking Bryde's whales for Scientific Research purposes, and 120 animals were caught north of 40° South.

The quotas set for minke whales were sub-divided on an Area basis, and the quota for sperm whales on a Division basis. Further, the quotas were split into national quotas by agreement between Japan, USSR and Brazil.

In the introduction to International Whaling Statistics No. LXXXIV the national quotas and the catches of the Japanese and USSR pelagic expeditions in the Southern Hemisphere are given for the season 1978/79 by Area and for sperm whales also by Division.

Portugal and Cyprus are not members of the Commission. Portugal caught 179 sperm whales in 1979 from the Azores and Madeira. No reports are received from Cyprus for the catch in 1979 by the combined floating factory/catcher vessel «Sierra», which is registered in Cyprus.

At the 32nd Annual Meeting of the International Whaling Commission in Brighton in 1980 tables were presented showing the Spanish catch from 1960 to 1979 and the Peruvian catch from 1968 to 1979. The data differ slightly from figures previously published, and revised statistics will be found in tables 1 (Spain) and t (Peru).

Tables Z²—Z¹¹ show the catches of small cetaceans reported to International Whaling Statistics. The figures for the Greenlanders catch of whales and porpoises given in tables Z²—Z¹¹ are provisional. The figures presented in previous volumes are not in full agreement with summaries of the «List of Game» published by the Ministry of Greenland. A revision of the statistics for the last decade is in progress by the said Ministry and will be published later.

From the United States Department of Commerce revised reports have been received of the estimated number of porpoises and dolphins killed by fishermen in the international tuna purse seine fishery in the Eastern tropical Pacific Ocean. These estimates are reported from the Status of Porpoise Stocks Workshop held in August 1979, and are assumed to be better than those reported previously. The total kill includes both direct kill and serious injury. (See Introduction to publication Nos. LXXIII, LXXV, LXXVII, LXXIX and LXXXI.) The revised estimates are printed in table Z¹².

Canadian catches of white whales (table Z⁷) and narwhal (table Z⁹) previously reported do not include the catch from Northern Quebec. According to the Government of Canada, information on catches of Quebec-based native hunters is now becoming available, and a split of the “Hudson and James’ statistical reporting area” will be necessary. Statistics will henceforth be reported in the following manner:

Eastern Hudson Bay, James Bay and Northern Quebec.

The estimated catch of white whales in Northern Quebec is published in table Z⁷. The estimation is based on the actual reported harvest by participating hunters, but statistically corrected to allow for missing data from potential hunters in the communities. The figures for 1977 and 1978 are provisional. The catch for 1979 is not yet available.
