This publication, International Whaling Statistics No. LXXXVII, embraces the world aggregate whaling results for 1980, i.e. the catch by Antarctic pelagic expeditions in the Southern Hemisphere in the 1979/80 season and the catch of shore stations during the calendar year 1980. With regard to the Japanese coastal catch of sperm whales, see Introduction to publication No. LXXXV, page 8.

## INTRODUCTION

Statistics on whales caught by Antarctic pelagic expeditions in the season 1979/80 are published in International Whaling Statistics No. LXXXVI.

At the 31st Annual Meeting of the International Whaling Commission in 1979 it was agreed to forbid the use of factory ships or whale catchers attached to factory ships for taking, killing or treating of whales, excluding minke whales.

At the meeting catch limits were set for the 1979/80 pelagic season and the 1980 coastal season. The catch limits apply to member countries of the Commission. No catch limits have been introduced for the small cetaceans. The catch limits for the Southern Hemisphere were the following:

Minke whales .....	8,102
Bryde's whales .....	264
Sperm whales .....	580

Bryde's whales and sperm whales could only be taken from shore stations.

The catch limit for minke whales was by agreement between Japan, USSR and Brazil split into national quotas. (See International Whaling Statistics No. LXXXVI.)

At the 32nd Annual Meeting of the International Whaling Commission in 1980 tables were presented showing the Spanish catch in the period 1960—1979. The data differed from figures previously published. Revised statistics have been published in table 1 on page 18 in publication No. LXXXV.

At the annual meeting of the International Whaling Commission in 1981 Spain supplied catch data for the period 1957—1980. On the basis of the information given, annual catches are shown in table 1. As will be seen these catches are in disagreement with previously published data on page 19 in publication No. LXXXIII and on page 18 in publication No. LXXXV.

Statistics have been received from the Portuguese Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries for Madeira and the Azores for 1979 and 1980. The catch from the Azores amounted to 60 sperm whales in 1979 and 66 in 1980. However, according to the newspaper "O Telegrafo," for 20 January 1980 and 11 February 1981 the catch amounted to 127 sperm whales in 1979 and 144 in 1980. The figures given by "O Telegrafo," are used in table j as it is likely that the Portuguese data do not comprise the catch from all islands involved.

Tables Z<sup>2</sup>—Z<sup>11</sup> show the catches of small cetaceans. The Committee on small cetaceans writes the following in a report presented at the 1981 meeting of the International Whaling Commission:

"Catch statistics provided to the Scientific Committee or to BIWS by member nations are in large part incomplete or inadequately detailed. The Committee again recommends that member nations be requested to collect and submit full statistics as detailed in Rep.Int.Whal.Comm.30:124. Member nations known to have taken but which did not report the takes or reported them incompletely include Argentina (Incidental), Australia (I), Brazil (I), Canada (Directed and I), Chile (I), France (D I), Iceland (Live-capture), Republic of Korea (I), Mexico (I), Netherlands (I), Peru (I), Seychelles (D), Spain (I), UK (I), USA (D, I, L) and USSR (I)..,

In tables Z<sup>2</sup> and Z<sup>11</sup> under "Others," will be found the total catch or incidental kill of several species of small cetaceans. The figures are based upon Appendix 3 in the 1981 report of the committee on small cetaceans.

The Government of Canada has revised the table showing catch of white whales in 1969. The revised figures are found in table Z<sup>7</sup>. See also introduction to publication No. LXXXV, page 10.

## INTRODUCTION

At the 32nd Annual Meeting of the International Whaling Commission in 1980 the catch limits for the Southern Hemisphere for the 1980/81 pelagic season and the 1981 coastal season were set at 886<sup>1)</sup>) Bryde's whales, 7,072 minke whales and 300 sperm whales.

It is forbidden to use a factory ship or whale catchers attached to factory ships for taking, killing or treating of whales, excluding minke whales. Bryde's whales and sperm whales could therefore only be taken by shore stations.

The catch limits for minke whales were sub-divided on an Area basis, and split into the following national quotas by agreement between Japan, USSR and Brazil:
