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PREFACE

This publication, International Whaling Statistics No. XCI, embraces the world aggregate whaling results for 1982, i.e. the catch made by Antarctic pelagic expeditions in the Southern Hemisphere in the 1981/82 season and coastal based cetacean catches during the calendar year 1982.

The statistical data are based on catch reports sent to the Bureau of International Whaling Statistics, Sandefjord.

No information has been received from Chile, Madeira, Azores and West Indies.

INTRODUCTION

Statistics on whales caught by Antarctic pelagic expeditions in the season 1981/82 are published in International Whaling Statistics No. XC.

At the 33rd Annual Meeting in 1981 catch limits were set for 1981/82 pelagic season and the 1982 coastal season. No catch limits have been introduced for small cetaceans, excluding minke whales.

The catch limits for the Southern Hemisphere 1981/82 pelagic season and 1982 coastal season were set at:

Tables Z³ — Z¹¹ show the catches of small cetaceans. The figures for the Greenland catch of whales and porpoises presented after 1977 were provisional. A revision of the statistics is in progress at the Ministry of Greenland. In publication Nos. LXXIII and LXXXIX revised statistics for the season 1965 to 1977 were presented. Revised statistics for the seasons 1977 and 1978 have now been received and are shown in table i for large whales and in tables Z² — Z¹¹ for small type cetaceans.

In publication No. LXXXIX (tables Z² and Z⁷) the estimated take of white whales in Alaska in 1981 is stated to be 125/196. Revised figures have now been received. The known take amounted to 150 animals, and the estimated take was 182/237.

Catches by USA under table Z¹¹ recorded as Harbour porpoises in pre-

vious publications should be Common dolphin (*Dolphinus delphis*). Said catches are now listed under Z¹¹ (catch of others or unspecified whales).

Under "Others" (tables Z² and Z¹¹) will be found the total catch of incidental, directed and live capture of small cetaceans. The figures are based upon Appendix 4 in the 1983 report of the IWC Scientific Committee's subcommittee on small cetaceans (see introduction to No. LXXXVII).

The Japanese production of oil from small whales amounted to 597 barrels.

INTRODUCTION

At the 34th Annual Meeting of the International Whaling Commission in 1982 the catch limits for the Southern Hemisphere for the 1982/83 pelagic season and the 1983 coastal season were set at 7,072 minke whales and 165 Bryde's whales (Peruvian Stock).

The catch limit for minke whales was subdivided on an Area basis, and split into the following national limits by agreement between Japan, USSR and Brazil:
