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PREFACE

to publication No. XCIII and XCIV.

Publication No. XCIII embraces the world aggregate whaling results for 1983, i.e. the catch made by Antarctic pelagic expeditions in the Southern Hemisphere in the 1982/83 season and coastal based cetacean catches during the calendar year 1983.

Publication No. XCIV (from page 51) embraces the results of the Antarctic whaling during the season 1983/84.

The Bureau of International Whaling Statistics, Sandefjord, has published the International Whaling Statistics since 1930, covering a total of 94 publications. The Secretary of the Bureau has always been the Secretary of the Norwegian Whaler's Association, which later incorporated some foreign whaling companies and was re-named the International Association of Whaling Companies. The members of this association have, with the exception of the Icelandic company (Hvalur H.F.), ceased whaling.

The International Association of Whaling Companies was disbanded in 1970, and it was suggested to transfer the publishing of the whaling statistics to the Secretariat of The International Whaling Commission. However, as the Commission's Secretariat lacked the necessary capacity to undertake this work, it was agreed that the Bureau in Sandefjord should continue the publishing for the present.

All expenses in connection with the publishing of the statistics are debited to the Whaling Industry's Control Impost Fund. This fund was created by taxing each barrel of oil produced by the Norwegian whaling companies. Through the years it is in fact the former Norwegian whaling companies that indirectly have financed the publishing of the whaling statistics.

The Norwegian Commissioner to the International Whaling Commission has informed this organisation that the publishing of the statistics should now be transferred to The International Whaling Commission's Secretariat. These are therefore the last two publications issued by the Bureau of International Whaling Statistics, Sandefjord. Reports on catches in the Antarctic in the 1984/85 season, and in areas other than the Ant-

arctic in 1984, should accordingly in future be sent to the International Whaling Commission, The Red House, Station Road, Histon, Cambridge CB4 4NP. Any reports sent to Sandefjord will be forwarded to the Commission.

The preface to publication No. I which was published in 1930 included the following statement:

” The Whaling Committee of The International Council for the Study of the Sea passed the following recommendation at the meeting held in London on April 10, 1929:—

The Committee is unanimous in asking the Council to request the Norwegian Government to organize a central institution to collect statistics from the whaling industry throughout the world, on the understanding that a report be laid before this Committee yearly.

In this recommendation it was further suggested as being desirable:—

1.—That the statistics be collected from every country, also from such as are not members of The International Council for the Study of the Sea.

2.—That statistics for previous years be collected—at least for every post-war year—from all countries.

3.—That a list be submitted each year of all whaling companies in operation, with particulars of the number of catchers employed.

4.—That the statistics be given yearly, if possible.

The Council thereupon transmitted this recommendation to the Norwegian Government, who have acted upon it by appointing on August 16, 1929 a committee comprising Messrs. Gunnar Jahn, Director of the Norwegian Statistical Central Bureau (Chairman), Professor Johan Hjort, and Sigurd Risting, Secretary of the Norwegian Whalers' Association, to plan and publish the statistics solicited by The International Council for the Study of the Sea.

The Committee first inquired into the possibility of building international statistics upon the official returns of the various countries. It was soon found, however, that such returns would not serve the purpose and that the best results would be obtained by employing the whaling statistics collected for several years by the Norwegian Whalers' Association.

This Association, through its secretary Mr. Sigurd Risting, has endeavoured to collect statistics of the whaling industry throughout the world during a long term of years. Its main object has been to furnish a picture of the progress of whaling operations at the several grounds from year to year, primarily by procuring particulars of the number of whales caught of the different species, the number of expeditions, catchers, and so forth. In addition, an attempt has been made to collect measurements in respect of the whales killed, information relating to the habits of the whale, and so on, with a view to procuring material that might throw light upon biological conditions. This information has been collected by means of forms sent out with each expedition. The forms have been filled in for a number of years by all Norwegian whalers and by a very large percentage of foreign companies, e.g., by the Argentine and British. Generally speaking, the forms contain all the information desired, and they have been used

by whalers for several years. It has therefore been deemed advisable to use them also for the seasons 1929-30 and 1930-31. For some countries the Whalers' Association has not had such returns. This applies to Japan, whose official statistics, it may be mentioned, contain fairly complete returns of the Japanese whaling industry, and also to the United States and Chile. To these two countries the Committee sent such forms through the Norwegian Ministry of Foreign Affairs, but they have not yet been returned, and the Committee has therefore had to build upon information from printed sources. Consequently it has not been possible to give such a detailed specification of the catches for those two countries.

Some of the material collected by the Whalers' Association has been prepared and published earlier, partly in the *Norsk Hvalfangertidende* (Norwegian Whalers' Gazette) and partly in Sigurd Risting's "Whales and Whale Foetuses", published by The International Council for the Study of the Sea in 1928.

After considering the various points in the recommendation of The Council for the Study of the Sea the Committee resolved to proceed first of all with the preparation of statistics for the past ten years comprising the number of whales of various species killed, number of expeditions and catchers. On the other hand, the Committee found it would not be able to deal with the measurement returns at present, although it is intended to reconsider the question next year, time permitting. Moreover, the Committee has set itself the task of preparing statistics for a further ten years back, so as to get continuous whaling statistics from the year 1910. The reason why this first publication does not go back beyond 1920 is that the Committee has not been in a position to prepare the material for the period 1910-20. A quantity of matter is available also for that decade, but many particulars are wanting in the material which the Committee is in possession of, and it will require time to secure them. The Committee quite realises that it would have been an advantage to publish the statistics for the whole of the 20-years period in one report, but, on the other hand, the Committee deemed it of such importance to make the returns for the post-war period available as speedily as possible that it could not further postpone publication.

The Committee entrusted its member Mr. Sigurd Risting with the preparation of the statistics."

Up to and including 1934/35 one publication was issued annually, which comprised both the Antarctic catch and catches in other areas. From the Antarctic season 1935/36 onwards two publications were issued annually, one on the Antarctic catch, and one on catches made in other areas of whaling, also including the main figures for the Antarctic catch.

Professor Johan Hjort withdrew from The Committee for Whaling Statistics in January 1939 and Professor Birger Bergersen was appointed a new member. He remained a member until his death in 1977. The Secretary, Mr. Sigurd Risting died in October 1935, and Mr. Harald B. Paulsen was appointed as the new Secretary, and he also became Secretary of The International Whaling Association. Mr. Paulsen died in 1952, and his successor was Mr. Einar Vangstein.

Director Mr. Gunnar Jahn was chairman of the committee from 1929 until his death in 1971.

No new committee members were appointed to replace Professor Bergersen and Director Jahn. The reason for this was that the publishing of the statistics was expected to be transferred to the International Whaling Commission.

According to the International Whaling Convention, statistical reports on catch and production are sent to the Bureau in Sandefjord. According to the Schedule to the Convention, the Bureau shall fix the date the adopted maximum catch is expected to be reached. The closing date was established by the Bureau of International Whaling Statistics for the seasons 1947/48 through 1958/59. The total maximum catch quota for these seasons was 186,000 blue-whale units, while the actual catch was 186,275 blue-whale units.

From 1959/60 the catch quota adopted by the International Whaling Commission was divided between the different countries by voluntary agreements between them, these countries also being responsible for not exceeding the maximum catch quota.

In addition to the publishing of whaling statistics, the Bureau for International Whaling Statistics has prepared special statistics for the annual meetings of the International Whaling Commission.

INTRODUCTION

Statistics on whales caught by Antarctic pelagic expeditions in the season 1982/83 are published in International Whaling Statistics No. XCII.

At the 34th Annual Meeting in 1982 catch limits were set for 1982/83 Antarctic pelagic season and the 1983 coastal season. No catch limits have been introduced for small cetaceans, excluding minke whales.

The catch limits for the Southern Hemisphere 1982/83 pelagic season and 1983 coastal season were set at:

A revision of the statistics is in progress at the Ministry of Greenland. In publication Nos. LXXIII, LXXXIX and XCI revised statistics for the seasons 1965 to 1979 inclusive were presented. Revised statistics for the seasons 1980 to 1982 inclusive have now been received and are shown in table i for large whales and in tables Z²—Z¹¹ for small cetaceans.

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INTRODUCTION

At the 35th Annual Meeting of the International Whaling Commission in 1983 the catch limits for the Southern Hemisphere for the 1983/84 pelagic season and the 1984 coastal season were set at 6,655 minke whales and 165 Bryde's whales (Peruvian Stock).

The catch limit for minke whales was subdivided on an Area basis, and split into the following national limits by agreement between Japan, USSR and Brazil:
