Summary

The survey Eurostudent 8, 2022 was conducted spring 2022. The purpose with the survey Eurostudent 8, 2022 was to find out how it is to be a student in Norway. The survey is conducted in many countries. The survey gives knowledge of the living conditions for the students in Norway.

In the sample for the survey Eurostudent 8, 2022 there were 23 819 students that we could find in our registers. Originally there were 24 000 students in the sample, but there is no possibility to reach the students with no contact information at all.

The survey was conducted as computer assisted web survey. The response rate for the survey Eurostudent 8, 2022 was 35.3 percent. Non-contact was the main reason for Non-response.

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1. Background

The Survey Eurostudent 8 was conducted in the spring 2022 by Statistics Norway. The Survey Eurostudent 8 is an investigation of how it is to be a student in Europe. The first, second, third, fourth, fifth, sixth and seventh waves of the survey were conducted in 2019, 2016, 2013 and 2010.

This report documents the data collection process for the survey Eurostudent 8, 2022. Table 1.1 presents the key figures for the survey.

In the Net sample we find the students that completed the survey. In the partially non-response category we find the students that did not complete the survey. At the end of the questionnaire there were some extra Covid-19 questions. Even if the respondents did not complete all questions about Covid-19, they are included in the Net sample.

2. Questionnaire

The questionnaire was adapted from the English Master Questionnaire. Additionally, the earlier

Norwegian questionnaires were used to construct the current questionnaire and maintain time series. Pre-testing and translation and adaptation was conducted by Statistics Norway. Usability tests were conducted in collaboration with Dag Gravem and Katharina Rossbach. The students could choose to answer in English or Norwegian, both “Bokmål” and “Nynorsk”, when they answered the web questionnaire.

3. Sample

3.1. Target population

The definition of the Eurostudent 8, 2022 target population is defined by the Eurostudent consortium: There is no upper age limit and no exclusion regarding nationality, citizenship or language. These students are excluded from the target population:

1. Students on (temporary) leave: students who have officially or non-officially interrupted their studies at the time of observation for whatever reason.
2. Students on credit mobility, short-time mobile students (e.g. Erasmus students): students who are currently studying in the country of observation (incoming) or who have currently left the country of observation (outgoing) for a short time period (e.g. one or two semesters) with the purpose of gaining only a relatively small number of credits.
3. Students in ISCED 8 study programmes (PhD- and Doctoral programmes).
4. Students in distance learning study programmes (only virtual classes) that DO NOT live in your country during the current lecture period.
5. Students at very specialised higher education institutions or higher education institutions directly affiliated with one company, where being a student/studying is part of the (paid) job description (e.g. military or police academies). That might also include programmes providing training only for public administration. The reason for this is that these students will have difficulties filling in larger parts of the questionnaire, e.g. if studying is part of their job (employment chapter) or if they live in a service apartment/barracks (housing and financing) or a mobility stay at a foreign university is actually a business trip (mobility).
6. Students in programmes classified as ISCED (2011) level 5, but not regarded as higher education in the national context. Mostly, these programmes are affiliated with the VET-system (Vocational Education and Training) or regarded as post-secondary or tertiary at national level, but not always also as higher education. Examples are programmes for becoming a Master craftsman in Germany or Austria, which are offered completely outside the higher education system, but categorised as ISCED level 5 in the national qualification framework. ISCED (2011) even qualifies the last 2 years of upper-secondary, professional schools in Austria as short-cycle programmes on ISCED level 5. However, these are offered at schools, not in higher education. Short-cycle programmes are in general very complicated to compare internationally. EUROSTUDENT regards them as part of the target group only if they are offered at higher education institutions.
7. Students enrolled in higher education but not entitled to finish a common programme. This might be students with an "extra-ordinary" or "guest" status or students only enrolled in single courses if they are not allowed to graduate from an entire, ordinary programme (i.e. their achievements will not be recognised for a common title like Bachelor or Master).

The population for Eurostudent 8, 2022 in Norway were students in higher education on the 15.03.2022 in the Database for higher education (DBH). See appendix A for more population and sample information.

With this definition, the size of the student population in Norway on the 15.03.2022 was 269,334 persons. Among these students, 23 819 persons were drawn and invited to take part in the Eurostudent 8, 2022 Survey in Norway. Students classified as Non-eligible were found by asking students filter-questions in the Eurostudent 8, 2022 questionnaire. They did not meet the criteria of

being a student according to the Eurostudent 8 definition of a student, and they are therefore not included in the Gross sample.

In addition, Statistics Norway chose to concentrate the data collection on students 18 years or older at the day of selection.

Table 3.1 shows the size of the population, in the sample, in the gross sample and the net sample.

4. Data collection

The Survey method was computer assisted web interview by self-completion.

The period of data collection was 29.04.2022 – 07.06.2022. An information letter was sent to respondents by e-mail to inform about the survey and motivate them to participate (see appendix B). An incentive was provided by six gift cards, five gift cards worth 2 000 NOK, and one gift card worth 5000 NOK which would be awarded the lucky participants through lottery among respondents that completed the interview. In addition to the main invitation-e-mail, the potential respondents also got e-mail and short SMS reminders (see appendix C) throughout the data collection process.

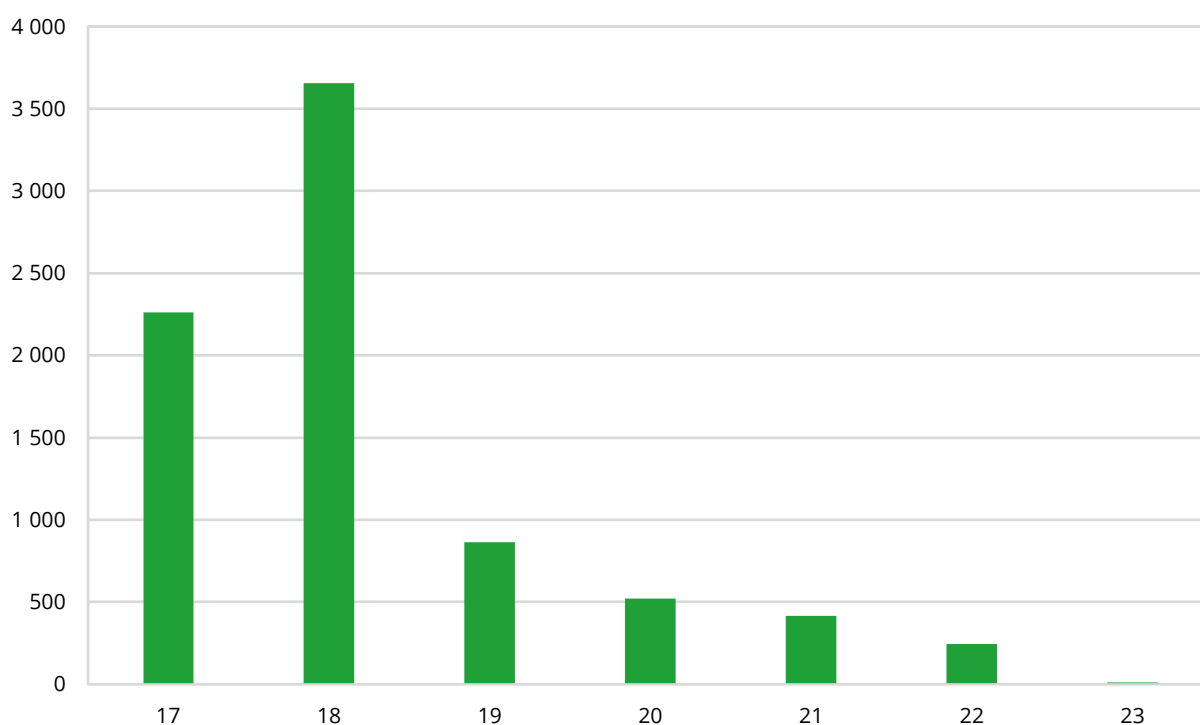
The mode of data collection for the Survey Eurostudent 8 was computer assisted web interview by self-completion.

The average time per interview was 28 minutes. In the following up of non-response and refusals, we sent reminders with e-mail and SMS. We also sent reminders to the students that had started answering the web-questionnaire, but not yet completed. They got a link in the SMS where they could start completing their questionnaire where they had left the last time they had logged in to the web-questionnaire.

We started the data collection process in week 17 and ended the data collection in week 23. By the end of the data collection period, there were 7 938 interviews at a gross response rate of 35.3 percent.

Figure 4.1 shows the accumulated number of interviews for each week during the data collection period.

5. Data quality

5.1. Sample Bias

Non-response error might lead to sample bias when the distribution of certain characteristics differs between respondents who were randomly drawn to present the population as whole (the gross sample) and respondents that actually participated in the survey (net sample). Sample bias related to one characteristic does not necessarily imply that the net sample is biased related to other characteristics. Strong correlation for one characteristic is no guarantee for an unbiased net sample when it comes to the distribution of other characteristics.

Sample bias may also be the product of sampling error, i.e. when distribution of a certain characteristic in the gross sample deviates from the distribution of the same characteristic in the target population. Coverage error is another source of sample bias and occurs when the sample source is flawed and poorly represents the population.

When assessing sample bias, attention should primarily be directed towards the differences between the net sample and the gross sample rather than between the gross sample and the population. In the latter case, deviations are due to coincidences when drawing a sample. When looking at a specific population group, persons included in the (gross) sample can be expected to not deviate systematically from persons excluded from the sample, other things held constant. However, when comparing the gross sample to the net sample, there is a risk that respondents who participated in the survey (net sample) have systematically different characteristics from respondents who did not participate (non-response).

Table 5.1 lists the distribution of the characteristics sex, age, education and the respondents' region address (region in Norway) from register in the gross sample, the net sample and in the non-response group. The last column illustrates whether different groups are under-represented (negative values) or over-represented (positive values) in the net sample compared to the gross sample. The strongest deviations between the gross and net samples are found in the sex variable. Women are over-represented, while men are under-represented. Students in the age group 18-24 years are over-represented, while students in the age group 25-44 years are under-represented.

5.2. Non-Response

Out of the 23 819 students randomly drawn for the sample, 1324 students answered the Eurostudent 8, 2022 questionnaire and told us they were either not studying in Norway, or that they were students not living in Norway studying online study programme or Phd-students. Given that those persons are considered ineligible for the Eurostudent 8, the size of the gross sample is 22 495. Computer assisted web interviews by self-completion were conducted with 7 938 students according to the definition of an Eurostudent student, 35.3 per cent of the gross sample. The share of non-response was 64.7 percent of the gross sample, 14 557 persons.

Several strategies were utilised to mitigate non-response. The students we did not have the electronical contact information to, received a postal invitation letter in the mail. The other students received the invitation to take part in the survey by e-mail invitations (see appendix B) and SMS (see appendix C) from Statistics Norway. Both postal and digital letters were containing the information about the survey. In the invitation to take part in the web survey, Statistics Norway tries to motivate respondent participation, and to form the basis of the respondents' informed consent to participate in the survey, a formal condition for collecting data through personal interviews.

Table 5.2 indicates that not getting in contact with the selected respondent is by far the most frequent cause of non-response, 52.1 percent of the gross sample. Not having completed the survey was the case of 10.1 percent of the gross sample. Table 4.2 illustrates how participation and non-

response by main causes are distributed by respondents' sex, age, residence by region in Norway and education from registry information in Statistics Norway.

The response rate among women is higher than among men. 37.8 percent of the women completed the survey, and 10.9 per cent of the women started to answer the survey without completing it. Only 31.3 of the men completed the survey, and 8.9 per cent of the men started to answer the survey without completing it. Concerning non-response causes, it is more difficult to get in contact with men than women. Statistics Norway could not get in contact with 57.1 per cent of the men in the gross sample, while the percent for women was 48.8.

The difficulty of getting in contact with the respondent is the main problem in this survey. Looking at respondent's age, the highest share of no contact, 55.3 percent, is in the age-group 25-44 years, and the highest response rate, 37.7, is in the age-group 18-24 years.

The difference between the regions with the highest and the lowest response rate, "Innlandet" and "Oslo and Viken", is 4 percentage points. The share of respondents classified as no contact is highest in "Vestlandet" and "Agder and Sør-Østlandet" (52.6 percent) and "Oslo and Viken" (52.5 percent).

By introducing education from register in Statistics Norway, we find some differences. While the response rate for respondents with no and lower education is 31.4 percent, the response rate for respondents with higher education is 35.5 percent. The response rate for respondents with unknown education is 24 percent. Registry information in Statistics Norway about "Unknown education" includes mainly people that have not been in contact with the Norwegian educational system, for example, immigrants. 67.5 percent no contact for the people with registry information "unknown education", can maybe indicate that some of the immigrants no longer live in Norway, or due to backlog in the registers for immigrants.

6. Statistical uncertainty and sampling errors

The sample for Eurostudent 8, 2022 was drawn randomly from the Database for higher education, and registry information from BeReg, Statistics Norway's copy of the Central Population Register in Norway. Using a sample survey, we can estimate the prevalence of various phenomena for the population using statistical inference. This saves considerable costs but introduces some uncertainty. We can quantify this uncertainty using sampling theory and the probability of each person/unit drawn to the sample.

The method used to calculate an estimate is called an estimator. There are two aspects of an estimator that are important. First, the estimator should be unbiased and therefore give approximately the correct value on repeated attempts. That is, if we repeatedly draw samples, the values of the estimates should be centered around the true population value. In addition, we measure of how much variation around the population value the estimates have with repeatedly drawn samples. This variation is the statistical uncertainty of the estimate, usually measured as the standard error (SE) of the estimate. The SE is defined as the estimated standard deviation of the estimate and tells us how much an estimate will, on average, deviate from the true value.

As an illustration, we want to estimate the percentage of women, P_0 , in a population with size N . We draw a random sample without replacement from the population with size n , so that all units have the same selection probability (n/N). If P is calculated as the percentage of women in the sample, it will be an unbiased estimate for P_0 . The standard error is given by:

$$SE(P) = \sqrt{\frac{P(100-P)}{n} \cdot \left(1 - \frac{n}{N}\right)}$$

The exact difference between P and P_0 unknown. The margin of error describes the size of the distance with which a specified percentage of the results is expected to vary from the true percentage. The margin of error is defined as approximately $2 \cdot SE$ for a 95 percent confidence level. This gives a confidence interval of

$$(P - 2 \cdot SE, P + 2 \cdot SE)$$

This means we are 95 percent confident that the interval contains the true value P_0 . With repeated samples, 95 percent of the intervals calculated will cover the true value P_0 . For derivation of these formulas and corresponding results for more complicated sampling plans such as stratified samples and multistage samples, see Bjørnstad (2000).

The following fact box provides definitions of concepts and formulas for estimating percentages in a population based on a sample.

In most of Statistics Norway's sample surveys, the sample consists of a very small proportion of the population. The target population is generally large, for example the Norwegian population, all workers, or all Norwegian companies. This means that the sample proportion n/N is negligible, and the second part of the SE formula (known as a finite population correction) can be ignored giving

$$SE = \sqrt{\frac{P(100 - P)}{n}}$$

The size of the confidence interval will therefore depend only on the size of the sample and not on the population size. The standard error becomes smaller the more people who are included in the sample. However, the relationship between the size of the standard error and n is not linear and to get the standard error halved, with the same value of P , the sample size must be quadrupled.

The standard error is greatest when the sample result is 50 percent and decreases symmetrically as the percentage approaches 0 or 100.

Instead of making calculations for each individual result, Table 5.1 can be used. It displays standard errors for observed percentages by sample size, drawn using simple random sampling.

Based on table 6.1, a sample result of 30 percent from a simple random sample with 22,000 units has a standard error of 0.3 percentage points. This means that the margin of error is 0.6 percentage points and the 95 per cent confidence interval for the percent is (29.4, 30.6). We can estimate with 95 percent confidence that this interval contains the true population value.

6.1. Example of using formula and table

We want to estimate how many students have their lectures recorded. To answer this question, we have received responses in a survey from 7 918 respondents (n) who are drawn from the student population that follows the Eurostudent 8 definition. As of 15.03.2022, this was 269,334 people (N). In the survey, 4 348 respondents (x) state that their lectures are recorded. The remaining 3 570 respondents state that their lectures are not recorded. The percent who have their lectures recorded is $x/n = 4\,348 / 7\,918 = 0.549$ or 54.9 percent. Since $n/N = 0.0293$ is very small, we can use the simplified formula for SE to get the confidence interval

$$54,9 \pm 2 \sqrt{\frac{54,9(100-54,9)}{7\,918}} = 54,9 \pm 2 (0,56) = 54,9 \pm 1,1$$

The population estimate for the percent who have their lectures recorded is the same as in the sample, 54.9 percent. The margin of error for the estimate is 1.1 percentage points, while the 95 percent confidence interval for the percent is (53.8, 56.0).

Alternately, we can use Table 5.1. The closest values in the table are 8 000 for the sample size and 45/50 for the sample percent, giving a standard error of 0.6. The 95 percent confidence interval is $54,9 \pm 2 (0,6) = (53,7, 56,1)$, approximately the same as above.

7. Data collection errors and processing errors

The data collection mode in this survey was computer assisted web interviews (CAWI), using the interview programme Blaise developed in the Netherlands. Data entry control functions are built into the electronic questionnaire, which reduces the need for posterior data control. No errors of any importance were detected in the data control posterior to the data-collection period.

In sample surveys, there will be answers that are incorrect. The errors can occur in the collection phase and during processing.

The interviews in this survey were conducted online. The respondents completed a form on a computer or mobile device and received one or more questions at a time.

An advantage of using an online data collection method is that it allows you to pre-program filters, so questions are adapted to the respondent's situation and previous answers. It is also possible to automatically check response consistency between different questions. For some questions, limits are set for valid values, and an error message will appear on the screen if the respondent enters a value outside of these. For example, an error message will be shown if the respondent or interviewer enters a very high income value. A control question will then be given to confirm the respondent's income. This avoids registration of invalid values.

Pre-programmed filtering can also lead to fewer errors associated with incorrect flow of the survey questions. At the same time, programming errors are a risk associated with this type of survey method and in the worst case, can cause questions to become worthless. We have no evidence that there were any such errors in Eurostudent 8, 2022.

Data collection errors can also be caused by the respondent providing incorrect answers. This may be due to difficulties in remembering earlier events. It can also be caused by misunderstanding the questions. Furthermore, questions on events or things that are very complex, will likely result in erroneous answers. Respondents may also give incorrect answers to questions that are sensitive in nature. For example, questions about finances or health may be sensitive for some people and responses may be influenced by what the participant perceives as socially desirable. In the Eurostudent survey, for example, respondents may say that it is easier to be a student than they truly believe, because they perceive it as socially desirable to respond in this way.

Processing errors are discrepancies between the value that is recorded and the value that is used to create the statistics. Various checks are in place to find errors and correct them. No such processing errors have been found in this investigation.

When errors have been corrected as far as possible, experience shows that in most cases, the statistical results are relatively unaffected by both collection and processing errors. However, the effect of errors may be significant in some cases. This is especially true if the error is systematic, i.e. the same mistake is made relatively often. Random errors are likely to pull the estimates in both directions (higher and lower) and generally do not contribute to a bias in the estimates.

Appendix E: Weigting for Eurostudent 8

Target population and sample frame

For the purpose of sampling and non-response weighting in Eurostudent 8, Statistics Norway received individual records from the NSD database for higher education for all students enrolled (March 15, 2022) in ISCED 6-7, with the following exception:

- Students currently interrupting their studies (officially)
- Credit mobile students (incoming and outgoing)

Further groups were also excluded from the sampling frame prior to sampling by matching the data from the NSD database for higher education to register data from Statistics Norway:

- Students in military and police academies, which are not relevant for Eurostudent 8
- PhD-students
- Students enrolled in higher education but at a program at ISCED level 3, 4 or 5 (preparatory courses for engineers)

Furthermore, we excluded students who had not reached the age of 18 at the time of the field phase (April 2022).

Sampling

A simple random sample of 24 000 students was taken from the sampling frame. No stratification was done.

Response rate

Overall, 7 938 persons in the target group responded to the survey. Furthermore, 2 279 persons started the interview, but did not complete the questionnaire. Nearly half of the sample did not answer the survey.

This indicates an over-coverage rate of around 5%.¹ The register information in our sampling frame did not allow us to separate all students purely in distance learning from students in programs combining distance and face-to-face teaching and learning. There is also a high number of students currently studying abroad and having already graduated. This might indicate that register information is not fully updated.

Furthermore, 19 respondents were excluded from the target group due to missing information in the focus groups e_age, e_sex, e_hei and e_qualification.

This gave a total of 7919 responses from individuals that were in target population. The overall response rate, with the simplified assumption that all non-respondents were eligible, can be regarded as $7919/(24000 - 1324) = 34.92$ percent.

Sample bias

Non-response weighting is used to correct for the bias associated with selective response rates among groups. Auxiliary variables which are known for both the respondents and the full population (or full sample) are used to calculate the weights. Good variables to use when calculating non-response weights are those which are associated with both response probabilities and the variables of interest.

In the Eurostudent Handbook the recommended weighting variables are sex, age, qualification studied for (i.e. BA, MA, etc.), type of HEI and (if possible) field of study.

Field of study and study program (Bachelor, Master and other) are not easily available for the population, so are not used. Therefore, we investigate the recommended weighting variables sex, age and type of HEI.

Calculating percent differences between the gross and final net sample is a simple way of investigating if non-response varies among groups². This is calculated as

$$percentdiff = 100 \cdot \left(\frac{r_g}{r} - 1 \right)$$

Where r_g is the response rate within group g and r is the overall response rate. Table 1 gives a break-down of the numbers in the sample and respondents by the different variables.

The percentage differences indicate an under-representation of males, students at non-universities, as well as students in the age groups 25 – 29 and 30 +. In addition, some field of study are over-/underrepresented. Because we were not able to assign a field of study for nearly 2 000 of the sampled persons, we are not sure about the quality of the variable “field of study”. As field of study also is related to age and institution type, we would prefer not to use field of study as a weighting variable.

Quality of response variables

Some questions in the questionnaire have corresponding register variables, allowing us to check the quality of the responses.³ Registered institution type and responses correspond in most of the cases, whereas registered citizenship and responded citizenship do not correspond in all cases. This might be due to a delay in the registration.

For the purposes of consistency in the reporting, responses for type of institution were taken as the correct value illustrating the response bias and for weighting purposes.

Non-response weighting

The non-response weights used in Eurostudent VII need to be standardized to the sample size of respondents. This relates to the data reporting requirements. This is achieved by creating tables of counts for both respondents and the population of the crosses of the variables that will be used for the weighting. An expected number of respondents ($\hat{n}_g$) is calculated for each cell/group as:

$$\hat{n}_g = \frac{N_g}{N} \cdot n$$

Where N_g is the population total in group g , N is the total population size and n is the total number of respondents. The weight (w_g) for individuals in group g is then calculated as:

$$w_g = \frac{\hat{n}_g}{n_g}$$

Where n_g is the observed number of respondents in group g . From this it follows that if fewer than expected respond within a group, the weight will be more than 1 and if more than expected respond the weight will be less than 1. The sum of the weights multiplied by the number of respondents in each group should equal the total number of respondents.

Table 5 shows the cross-tabulation of the variables to create 24 weighting groups. The weights are well within the recommended boundaries (0.2 - 5.0) so we believe the groupings are reasonable.
